Plans and adjustments are also sent in to the Virginia Council of Private Education (VCPE) as established by the state.



Accommodations, protocols, and procedures to safeguard our students and their families.

Measures to safeguard the health and wellness of students and their families.

SOCIAL DISTANCING:

- Continue with the three separate drop off areas with temperature checks of all staff and children before entering the facility.
- Desks separated.
- Lunches will be held in the classrooms.
- Students will go directly to the rooms upon arrival at school
- Reduced number of students on the playground at any given time.
- Restroom schedules created to reduce the number of students in the hallway and/or restrooms.
- When not possible to social distance, masks may be worn.

CLEANING, SANITIZING & HYGIENE:

- Hand washing instruction will be taught and reinforced with staff and students as often as possible (i.e., before and after snack, after recess or outside, etc).
- Playgrounds sanitized several times a day
- Cleaning desks, classroom areas several times a day.
- Classrooms sanitized between student groups (in secondary level)
- Buses sanitized twice per day
- Bus - students will have assigned seating on the bus.
- Drinking fountains will be closed - bring water bottles from home and water bottles provided at school
- Shared devices will be sanitized between use.
- Toys disinfected regularly
- Hand sanitizing stations will be installed throughout the campus.

HEALTH AND SAFETY:

- Separate COVID/Sick Area established
- Additional volunteers for morning temperature checks
- Policies changed to encourage students to stay home if sick or exposed.
- Additional training
